### **WEATHER-RELATED EARLY DISMISSALS**



When weather-related early dismissals occur after the start of the school day, bus students will be dismissed when their **school districts dismiss**. Students, who are usually picked up by parent/guardians or are walkers, will be dismissed when Conewago Valley School District dismisses.

Phone calls from parents will not be accepted for dismissal requests. **We need to keep the phone lines open in order to receive information from the school districts about early dismissals.**

Please be alert to weather forecasts for incoming snow possibilities. If you wish to change your child's method of dismissal or request your student to be dismissed at a different time, **you must send in a note with your student for each day when there is a possible early dismissal.** Notes must be turned in to the homeroom teacher, on the day they are to be applied. You may not submit one note for the duration of the school year. **Emails to the offices at each campus (McSherrystown = [jdeal@stck8school.org](mailto:jdeal@stck8school.org) or Conewago = [spoist@stck8school.org](mailto:spoist@stck8school.org)) from parents will be accepted until 10:00 a.m. Again, a note or email must be delivered on each separate occasion. Emails after 10:00 a.m. will not be accepted for changes in dismissal.**

### **CELL PHONE and ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY - REMINDER**



Cell phones, and similar electronic devices, are distractive and disruptive to the educational process. The school has emergency procedures established to provide for the safety of the children. Use of cell phones could disrupt these procedures and are therefore discouraged.

If a student has an emergency during the school day, they may use the phone in the Office. Parents who need to contact a student during the school day must contact the Office. Any changes to after school transportation arrangements must be made through the Office, preferably by a written note in the morning.

This policy applies to cell phones, pagers or any telecommunication devices that are capable of two-way transmission, be it audio, video or text.

**Cell phones and electronic devices will not be permitted for students in grades K-5 (exception may be granted after consultation with principal). Students in grade 6-8 may bring cell phones/electronic devices to school under the following conditions:**

- Parents must sign a permission form prior to the student bringing a cell phone to school.
  - All cell phones will be placed in a container, or plastic bag labeled with the student's name and grade. It must be dropped off in the office in the morning and retrieved by the student in the afternoon, prior to leaving school.
  - Any electronic devices that are found on school property during the school day will be confiscated and a parent must make arrangements with the Administration to retrieve the device.
  - Inappropriate or unlawful use of a cell phone at school or any after school activity will result in further disciplinary action.
