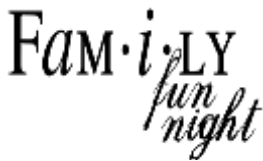

UNIFORM DRESS CODE: There have been some questions about the wearing of sweatshirts and physical education uniform clothing. Please note the following excerpts from pages 47-48 of the Handbook.

• **NOTE: There will be a transition phase of two (2) years for our consolidated students (Annunciation B.V.M., Immaculate Conception B.V.M. and Sacred Heart) to the new school uniforms.**

• According to the Standards of Modesty and Neatness (*page 48*), Students may wear the new St. Teresa of Calcutta Catholic School uniform clothing or the uniform clothing from THEIR OWN former school during the school day. The physical education uniform would be the same as a student's previous school or the new St. Teresa of Calcutta Catholic School.

- Also, students have the option of wearing **Solid navy sweater-vest, v-neck, crewneck cardigan, or quarter-zip fleece pullover with school logo.**
- **If a student wants to wear a sweatshirt in the classroom during the school day, it must be an official uniform sweatshirt with the school logo.** The school logo means St. Teresa of Calcutta, ABVM, ICBVM, or Sacred Heart during the two year transition period.
- It has been recommended that students have an "outside" jacket or sweatshirt that they can put on when they go outside, and then take off when they come inside. Preferably, the outside sweatshirt would not be the same sweatshirt that is worn in the classroom.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation with the uniform expectations.

RACE FOR EDUCATION UPDATE:



Our annual Race for Education will be held on **Friday, April 20th** at Delone Catholic High School. 100% of the money collected will help to provide affordable tuition for ALL our students who want a quality Catholic education.

 - 5th & K – orange t-shirt

 - 7th & 3rd – white t-shirt

If your child does not have a St. Teresa's shirt in the color they are asked to wear, they may wear an appropriate t-shirt in the color designated to their grade. These colors have been matched up by prayer partner grades and will help us recognize each class.

****Please have all jackets/sweatshirts marked with your child's name and grade.**

NOTE: Families who submitted addresses for the Race for Education, will find an envelope in their family folder with incentive coupons for your child(ren). These are the incentives for 5, 10 and 20 addresses.

2018 – 2019 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE NOW AVAILABLE



Deadline April 17, 2018

Financial assistance is available for families of St. Teresa of Calcutta Catholic School. Scholarships are available to all families who meet the criteria for E.I.T.C. scholarships. The online FACTS application is now open for you to apply for 2018 – 2019 school scholarships. The FACTS application is used to determine eligibility for the Neumann Scholarship and all school scholarships. You will find the link to FACTS on our school's website.

The Neumann Scholarship is offered to qualified Pennsylvania resident families only. This scholarship is offered to qualified students attending Catholic schools in the Diocese of Harrisburg, on a basis of need. This scholarship is available for grades Pre-Kindergarten to grade 12.

We also encourage all families to apply for the Family Choice Scholarship (This scholarship is available to families who reside in the State of Pennsylvania and is sponsored by the Pennsylvania Family Institute.)
