



School Symptom Screening Tool - PDE Guidance for Reopening Schools

Has the student/employee taken any medication to treat or reduce a fever? If so, when?

Is the student/employee experiencing any of the following:

Group A 1 or more symptoms	Group B 2 or more symptoms
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Fever (100.4 or higher)● Cough● Shortness of breath● Difficulty breathing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Sore throat● Runny nose/congestion● Chills● New lack of smell or taste● Muscle pain● Nausea or Vomiting● Headache● Diarrhea

Stay home or go home if a student/employee has: one or more symptoms in group A, two or more symptoms in group B, or has taken fever reducing medication. Student is to stay home for 48 hours symptom free.

HEALTH POLICY

Any student with a fever greater than 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit (38 degrees Celsius) or displaying any COVID-19 symptom (see the following slide or Appendix A of reopening plan) will be quarantined in a dignified manner in a designated location in the school building. Parents will be notified immediately to pick up their child. The student will NOT be permitted back to school until they are fever free and symptom-free for a period of 48 hours AND when the student has been cleared by a physician's note.

Any parent who keeps their child home because of 1 or more symptoms in Column A or 2 or more symptoms in Column B of the COVID-19 symptom checklist will follow the same protocols above.
